STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Removal of Snow from State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. The state highway commission shall cause the
2 clearance and removal of snow from such state highways
3 as they deem advisable and feasible during the winter sea4 son.

Sect. 2. Such clearance shall be for the purpose of mak-2 ing such state highways suitable for use during the winter 3 season by automobiles but it shall not be to such an extent 4 as to make such highways incapable of use at the same time 5 by sleds.

Sect. 3. Whenever the commission designates any state

2 highway for such purpose, they shall indicate the termini 3 of the part thereof which is to be so cleared and the con-4 tinuous section between such termini shall be cleared of 5 the snow encumbering the same to the extent hereinbefore 6 provided.

Sect. 4. The expense of so clearing the state highways 2 during the winter shall be borne wholly by the state.
