STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to a Tax Upon Gasoline.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-
2 five is hereby amended by striking out in the first line thereof
3 the word "three" and inserting in place thereof the word
4 'four' and by striking out in the seventh line thereof the
5 word "two" and inserting in place thereof the word 'three',
6 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'There is hereby levied and imposed an excise tax of four-
2 cents per gallon upon said internal combustion engine fuels
3 sold within this state and for the uses defined in this act;
4 excepting however, such internal combustion engine fuels in:

5 such form and under such circumstances as shall preclude
6 the collection of this tax from the distributor by reason of
7 the provisions of the laws of the United States, or sold
8 wholly for exportation from the state, provided that three
9 cents of the tax so paid and no more, upon such internal
10 combustion engine fuels sold for exclusive use in motor
11 boats, tractors used for agricultural purposes not operating
12 on public ways or in such vehicles as run only on rails or
13 tracks, or sold for use in stationary engines, or sold for use
14 in the mechanical or industrial arts, shall be refunded as
15 hereinafter provided.'
