STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Trial Terms of the Supreme Judicial Court in the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-one of chapter eighty-two of the revised stat-

- 2 utes of Maine, as amended by chapters seventy-three, two
- 3 hundred eleven and two hundred twenty-seven of the public
- 4 laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, and by chapter one
- 5 hundred eighty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred
- 6 twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the words
- 7 "the fourth Tuesday of April" in the paragraph fixing the
- 8 terms of court in Hancock county, and substituting in place
- 9 thereof the words 'the second Tuesday of May,' so that said
- 10 paragraph shall read as follows:

'Hancock, at Ellsworth, on the second Tuesday of May 2 and second Tuesday of October;'
