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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-one of chapter eighty-two of the revised statutes of Maine, as amended by chapters seventy-three, two hundred eleven and two hundred twenty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, and by chapter one hundred eighty-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the words "the fourth Tuesday of April" in the paragraph fixing the terms of court in Hancock county, and substituting in place thereof the words 'the second Tuesday of May,' so that said paragraph shall read as follows:

'Hancock, at Ellsworth, on the second Tuesday of May  
2 and second Tuesday of October;'
