AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Central Heating Company of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. P. & S. L., 1925, c. 56, Charter Rights Ex
tended. The rights, powers and privileges of the Central

Heating Company, of Portland, which were granted by

chapter fifty-six of the private and special laws of nineteen

hundred and twenty-five are hereby extended two years

additional, and the persons named in said act and their

associates and successors shall have the rights, powers and

privileges that were granted to them by said act to be

9 exercised by them for the same purposes as specified in 10 said act.

Sect. 2. Existing Statutes not Affected; Rights Conferred 2 Subject to R. S., c. 55. Nothing herein contained is intend-3 ed to repeal or shall be construed as repealing the whole or 4 any part of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties 5 herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in ac-6 cordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-7 five of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or 8 additional thereto.
