STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

**AN ACT to Incorporate the Milo Water District, in the
County of Piscataquis.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The following territory and the people within
2 the same, namely, the town of Milo in the county of Piscata-
3 quis, shall constitute a body politic and corporate under
4 the name of the Milo Water District, for the purposes of
5 supplying the inhabitants of said district with pure water
6 for domestic, sanitary, commercial and municipal purposes.

Sect. 2. The said district for the purpose of its incorpo-
2 ration, is hereby authorized to take, hold, divert, use, and
3 distribute water from Sebec River, in the town of Milo, and

4 from any surface or underground brooks and springs in
5 said Milo.

Sect. 3. The said district, for the purpose of its incorpo-
2 ration is hereby authorized to take and hold, as for public
3 uses, by purchase or otherwise, any land or interest therein
4 or water rights necessary for erecting and maintaining dams,
5 for flowage, for power for pumping its water supply through
6 its mains, for reservoirs, for preserving the purity of the
7 water and water shed, for laying and maintaining aqueducts
8 and other structures for taking, distributing, discharging and
9 disposing of water and for rights of way or roadways to
10 its sources of supply, dams, power stations, reservoirs,
11 mains, aqueducts, structures and lands.
