STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Southwest Harbor, Hancock County, to Raise and Appropriate Money to Purchase or Take by Eminent Domain a Lot of Land for a Public Park and for Municipal Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of Southwest Harbor, a
2 municipal corporation, in the county of Hancock and State
3 of Maine, are hereby authorized to raise and appropriate
4 money by taxation to purchase or take by eminent domain
5 and maintain a certain lot of land in said town of South-
6 west Harbor, known as the Holmes Lot, for a public park
7 and for municipal purposes.
