IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Registration of Motor Vehicles.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Every owner of a motor vehicle, before receiving a certificate of registration, shall present to the secretary of state an application, for such registration, bearing the endorsement of the clerk of the city, town or plantation where said owner resides.

Sect. 2. Before endorsing an application for registration the clerk of a town, city or plantation shall record in a book kept for such purpose the following data, to wit: make of car; model; year manufactured, and maker's number.

Sect. 3. No fees shall be paid by the owner or the applicant to such clerk or to the city, town or plantation, but the clerk shall receive from his city, town or plantation a fee of twenty-five cents for each application, so by him endorsed.
