IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing Fares on Passenger Boats Plying Between the Westerly End of Peaks Island and the Mainland in Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That the schedule of fares on all passenger carrying boats
2 plying between the westerly end of Peaks Island and the
3 mainland in Portland shall be fifteen cents for single ride
4 ticket and one dollar for a book of ten ride tickets. This
5 act shall not apply to fares on boats carrying passengers
6 between the hours of seven o'clock in the afternoon and six
7 o'clock in the forenoon.
