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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to Uniform Accounting in Cities and Towns.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred sixty-one of the public laws of nine-  
2 teen hundred twenty-three is hereby amended by adding  
3 thereto the following section:

'Sect. 11. Whenever the state auditor shall be informed,  
2 or shall have reason to believe, that the accounts of any  
3 city or town are in confusion, inaccurate, or in any matter  
4 do not reflect the true financial condition, he may inquire  
5 into and audit the same; and the expenses of investigation  
6 or audit shall be paid in the same manner as provided in  
7 section five.'
