HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" TO HOUSE PAPER NO. 17.

House Paper No. 17 is hereby amended by striking out
2 all of said bill after the enacting clause and substituting in
3 place thereof the following:

Section 1. The Cumberland County Power and Light
2 Company is hereby authorized and empowered to take and
3 hold, by right of eminent domain, such lands and easements
4 as may be necessary for the proper location of its trans-
5 mission lines which are designed to carry voltages of five
6 thousand volts or more and of necessary appurtenances
7 thereto, located within the territory in which said company
8 is authorized to do a public utility business, in the same

9 manner and under the same conditions as set forth in chap-
10 ter sixty-one, sections eleven to twenty-two, of the revised
11 statutes and amendments thereto.

Sect. 2. This right shall not apply to lands or easements
2 located within 300 feet of an inhabited dwelling, nor to
3 lands and easements on or adjacent to any developed or
4 undeveloped water power.

Sect. 3. The location of such transmission lines shall be
2 approved by the county commissioners of the county in
3 which the transmission lines are located.
