STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Set Off a Part of the Town of Penobscot in the County of Hancock, and Annex the same to the Town of Castine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All of that part of the town of Penobscot, in the county 2 of Hancock, bounded and described as follows: Beginning 3 at a stone post at the junction of the northerly corner of 4 land of Duncan Dunbar in the town of Castine, and the 5 highway; thence continuing in a general northerly and west-6 erly direction along the right hand boundary of said high-7 way, a distance of approximately four thousand two hundred 8 twenty-four feet, to a stone on the northerly side of the 9 junction of said highway and the Docian shore road so-

10 called; thence southwesterly by the right hand side of said
11 Docian shore road to the town line of Castine at Morse
12 Cove bridge, so-called, a distance of approximately nine
13 hundred and ninety feet; thence running in a southerly and
14 easterly direction along the present dividing line between
15 said Castine and said Penobscot to the point of beginning,
16 is hereby set off from the town of Penobscot and annexed
17 to the town of Castine.
