STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of Two Hundred Fifty Copies
of "Portland by the Sea."

Resolved: That the state purchase from the Katahdin
2 Publishing Company two hundred and fifty copies of "Port-
3 land by the Sea" by Augustus F. Moulton at the cost of two
4 dollars a copy, said volumes to be exchanged or distributed
5 at the discretion of the State Librarian; and that there be
6 and hereby is appropriated for this purpose the sum of five
7 hundred dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS
