STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of One Hundred Fifty Copies
of "Two American Pioneers."

Resolved: That the state purchase one hundred and fifty
2 copies of the book entitled "Two American Pioneers," writ-
3 ten by Mary Alice Wyman, at three dollars per copy, said
4 books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the
5 state librarian; and that there be and hereby is appropriated
6 for this purpose the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars.
