STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Highmoor Farm, in the Town of Monmouth.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of five thousand dollars for the year from July first, 3 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June thirtieth, nine-4 teen hundred and twenty-eight, and five thousand dollars 5 for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-6 eight, to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, 7 for the maintenance of Highmoor Farm, in the town of 8 Monmouth. Said sum to be expended under the direction 9 of the Maine Agricultural Experiment Station.

This resolve provides the regular appropriation made for many years by the Legislature for the support and maintenance of Highmoor Farm, in the town of Monmouth.
