STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Leeds, for Reimburse-
ment for Money Expended in Rebuilding a Bridge.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated, to
2 be paid to the town of Leeds in the county of Androscoggin,
3 for certain amounts paid in rebuilding the bridge over "Dead
4 River," so-called, on the road leading from Wayne to
5 Oxford county, the sum of five thousand dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This bridge is the connecting link between Kennebec and Oxford counties. It is much traveled, particularly in the summer season. In the town of Leeds, there are ninety miles of road and many bridges. The up-keep of these is a very heavy drain upon the taxpayers of this town.
