## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Intelligence Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter forty-two of the revised statutes, is hereby amend-2 ed by adding section fourteen to said chapter, to read as 3 follows:

'Sect. 14. Any person who has been refused a license, or 2 whose license has been revoked, to carry on any employment 3 agency in the state, may petition a single justice of the 4 supreme judicial court sitting in equity, for a review of the 5 matter; and thereupon said justice shall order the munic-6 ipal officers to show cause, why such person should not be 7 granted a license, or have his license restored; and if after 8 such hearing said justice is satisfied that the license should 9 be granted or restored, he shall order said municipal officers 10 to act in accordance with his decree; and if said municipal 11 officers shall refuse to act in accordance therewith, within 12 a time limit set by said justice, said decree shall be con-13 strued as licensing said person, or restoring to him said 14 revoked license for the remainder of the year up to the 15 first day of May, next following.'

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
