STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Protect Pheasants in the Town of Poland in the County of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, 2 take, catch, kill or destroy any pheasant or pheasants at 3 any time in the town of Poland, in the county of Andro-4 scoggin.

- Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have 2 in possession at any time any pheasant or pheasants taken 3 in said town of Poland.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more 3 than fifty dollars and costs for each offense, and, in addition

- 4 thereto, five dollars for each pheasant taken, caught, killed,
- 5 destroyed or had in possession in violation of any provision
- 6 of this act.
 - Sect. 4. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within
- 2 their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint, original
- 3 and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial court
- 4 and superior courts in all prosecutions under this act.
- Sect. 5. Section two of chapter one hundred thirty-two
- 2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-five is
- 3 hereby repealed.
