IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Defining Dealers in Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-five of chapter two hundred eleven of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby
3 amended by adding at the end of said section the follow-
4 ing: 'The word "dealer" as used in this act shall mean any
5 person, firm or corporation actively engaged in the business
6 of buying, selling or exchanging motor vehicles and having
7 an established place of business for such purpose,' so that
8 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 55. Every manufacturer or dealer in motor vehicles
2 shall pay to the secretary the required registration fee for

3 the succeeding year on or before the thirty-first day of
4 December annually; provided, that any manufacturer or
5 dealer commencing business after the first day of January
6 of any year shall pay the fee at the time of commencing
7 business. The word "dealer" as used in this act shall mean
8 any person, firm or corporation actively engaged in the
9 business of buying, selling or exchanging motor vehicles
10 and having an established place of business for such pur-
11 pose.'
