Resolved: That there be paid to the South Kennebec

- 3 sum being the amount of the state stipend for the year nine-
- 4 teen hundred and twenty-one, withheld by the Department
- 5 of Agriculture.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The stipend for the year 1921 was withheld for alleged negligence in enforcing the laws against gambling. The fair officials assert that the Department's decision was not supported by the facts in the case.
