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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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AN ACT Relating to Precautions at Temporary Crossings.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section sixty-nine, chapter fifty-six of the revised  
2 statutes of Maine, revision of nineteen hundred and six-  
3 teen, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "team"  
4 wherever it appears in said section the words 'or vehicle,'  
5 so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'No team or vehicle shall be driven over any such cross-  
2 ing unless such team or vehicle shall first be stopped at the  
3 line of the railroad right of way and the driver thereof  
4 shall look and listen, and such driver or some other person  
5 for him shall go upon such crossing, ahead of such team  
6 or vehicle, and be satisfied that such team or vehicle may

7 safely be driven over such crossing. Nothing in this sec-  
8 tion shall prevent the public utilities commission from  
9 making such further regulations for safety at any such  
10 crossing established under their direction, as they may deem  
11 expedient or necessary.'
