STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Richard Jacobson, of East Waterford, Compensating Him for Damage Done His Orchard by Deer.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 compensate Richard Jacobson, of East Waterford, for dam-3 age done his orchard by deer, during the summer seasons 4 of nineteen hundred twenty-five and twenty-six, the sum of 5 one hundred and forty dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Jacobson had one hundred apple trees set out four years ago, of the Mackintosh and Delicious varieties. Deer repeatedly entered his orchard and browsed upon his trees, greatly injuring them.
