RESOLVE, in Favor of F. C. Handy for Reimbursement for
Checks Lost in the Mail.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to
2 be paid to Mr. F. C. Handy of Pownal, to reimburse him
3 for checks lost in the mail, the sum of fifty-eight dollars and
4 seventy-one cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These checks were drawn by the Treasurer of the State of Maine, to the aggregate amount of fifty-eight dollars and seventy-one cents in favor of seven different individuals. Mr. Handy cashed these checks and sent them by mail in an envelope addressed to the Lewiston Trust Co., which failed to receive them and the treasury department has not issued duplicates but has stopped payment upon the lost checks.
