IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sanitary Wrappers for Ice Cream Cones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall sell, or exhibit for sale, any ice cream
2 in edible ice cream cones, so-called, unless said cones are
3 fully enclosed in a sanitary covering or wrapper.
