STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

JOINT ORDER Relative to Welfare Conditions in the State
of Maine.

ORDERED, the Senate concurring, that a committee of
2 three, joined by two on the part of the Senate, be appointed
3 to examine the conditions, with reference to existing wel-
4 fare laws, including the operation of the laws, concerning
5 dependent mothers, wards of the state, charities and cor-
6 rections, patients at the insane hospitals, the School for
7 Feeble Minded at Pownal, State Reformatory for Women,
8 State Reformatory for Men, the State School for Boys,
9 the State School for Girls, giving particular attention to the
10 laws governing such dependents and institutions and to make

11 recommendations, if any, with regard to the laws concern-
12 ing the same. Also ordered that the committee shall make
13 its report to the eighty-fourth legislature and make its
14 recommendations as to the welfare legislation for the state.
