STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Expenditures of State Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one, chapter two hundred and fifteen, 2 public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen, is hereby 3 amended by inserting after the period following the word 4 "departments" in the last line, the words 'The expenditure 5 of appropriations and funds of said departments and the 6 limiting and extending of the scope of the functions there- 7 of shall be subject to the supervision and direction of the 8 governor and council,' so that said section as amended will 9 read as follows.

'Section 1. The salaries or wages of all assistants, clerks

2 and other employees of the several departments of the state
3 government shall be fixed by the governor and council upon
4 the recommendation of the heads of the respective depart-
5 ments. The expenditure of appropriations and funds of
6 said departments and the limiting and extending of the
7 scope of the functions thereof shall be subject to the super-
8 vision and direction of the governor and council.'

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
