# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No judge, clerk, register, or recording officer holding office 2 in the counties of this state shall write, furnish, or procure,

- 3 directly or indirectly, any bond which is by law required
- 4 to be furnished, filed or recorded in any office in which he
- 5 or she is such judge, clerk, register or recording officer.
