STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section one hundred thirty-three of chapter thirty-eight
2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one, is hereby
3 amended by inserting the words 'or town' in the sixth line
4 after the word "city," so that said section, as amended, shall
5 read as follows:

Sect. 133. An absentee voter is hereby defined to be any 2 person who is a duly qualified registered voter, and in re-3 spect to any primary election duly enrolled as a member of 4 the political party in the primary of which he proposes to 5 vote, but who through absence from the city or town in 6 which he is entitled to vote, is unable to cast his ballot at

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7 the polling place where he is entitled to vote, at any city or 8 town election, at any primary election held pursuant to 9 sections one, twenty-three and twenty-four of chapter six 10 of the revised statutes of Maine, or at any general or special 11 state election as the term state election is defined in section 12 one of chapter seven of the revised statutes of Maine, in-13 cluding also elections for the choice of electors of president 14 and vice-president of the United States, elections held in 15 accordance with the initiative or referendum provisions of 16 the constitution of Maine, and elections to vote upon amend-17 ments to the constitution of Maine.'
