# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Teacher's Pension for Fannie S. Marble.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter eighty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred 2 twenty-three is hereby amended by striking out in the sec-3 ond line after the words "pension of" the words "one hun-4 dred fifty," and inserting therein the words 'two hundred 5 fifty,' so that the chapter, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Fannie Marble, teacher's pension. Resolved: That there 2 be, and hereby is, granted to Fannie Marble a teacher's 3 retirement pension of two hundred fifty dollars annually 4 as provided by law for teachers who have made teaching 5 their life work for twenty-five years and that the state su-

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6 perintendent of public schools be authorized to grant said 7 pension quarterly as is customary for teachers who are re-8 tired under provisions of the law.'
