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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The town of Turner in the county of Androscoggin, at its  
2 option, is authorized to choose, by ballot at its annual meet-  
3 ings, a superintending school committee of five: the three  
4 members thereof who shall have served continuously as  
5 members of the superintending school committee of said  
6 town the longest terms, shall act as the committee from  
7 said town in forming the joint committee provided under  
8 section fifty-six of chapter sixteen of the revised statutes, as  
9 amended.
