STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Confer the Power to Issue Subpoenas to the City Council and Civil Service Commission of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The clerks of the supreme judicial and supe2 rior courts may issue summons for witnesses to attend and
3 to produce books, documents and papers at any meeting of
4 the city council or of the civil service commission of the
5 city of Portland at which a hearing is had in any matter
6 regarding any alleged dereliction of duty of any city officer
7 or any person in the employ of the city. Said summons
8 shall be served as summons are required to be served in
9 matters before the supreme judicial or superior courts.

Sect. 2. On complaint of failure to obey said summons 2 to the municipal court of the city of Portland, which court 3 is expressly given jurisdiction to hear such complaints, said 4 municipal court, if it finds failure to obey said summons 5 to be without reasonable excuse, shall impose a fine of not 6 less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars or by im-7 prisonment for not more than thirty days or both fine and 8 imprisonment.
