STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Protection of White Perch in Pemaquid and Biscay Ponds, and Macurda Pond, or Hilton Lake, in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of the existing laws, whether public

- 2 or private and special, as provide for a closed season on
- 3 white perch in Pemaquid Pond, situated wholly or partly
- 4 in Nobleboro, Damariscotta and Bremen; in Biscay Pond,
- 5 situated wholly or partly in Damariscotta, Bremen and
- 6 Bristol; and Macurda Pond, or Hilton Lake, so-called, sit-
- 7 uated wholly or partly in Bremen, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. This act shall not be construed as repealing that

- 2 portion of the existing general law establishing a daily limit
- 3 of fifteen pounds of white perch or not exceeding twenty-
- 4 five white perch which may be taken in one day in said
- 5 waters.
