STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Regulate Bass Fishing in Virginia Lake, in the
County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill, any black bass at any time in Virginia
3 Lake, in the town of Stoneham, county of Oxford, except
4 between the 20th day of June and the 30th day of Novem-
5 ber following of each year, both days inclusive, during which
6 open season it shall be lawful to fish in said lake for black
7 bass in accordance with the general law of the state apply-
8 ing to black bass fishing.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more

3 than thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and one dollar
4 additional for each fish taken, caught killed or had in pos-
5 session in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within
2 their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint, original
3 and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial court
4 and superior courts in all prosecutions arising under this act.
