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## STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for  
Emily F. Grotton, of Washington.

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Resolved: That a pension of twenty-five dollars per month  
2 be, and hereby is, granted to Emily F. Grotton, of Wash-  
3 ington, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for  
4 soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension  
5 shall begin July first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, and  
6 continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and  
7 shall be in lieu of the state pension which she is now re-  
8 ceiving.
