RESOLVE, in Favor of Lydia Jackson of Hollis, Providing
a State Pension.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated to be
2 paid to Lydia Jackson of Hollis, widow of George W. Jack-
3 son, a Civil War veteran, a pension of twelve dollars per
4 month, payable quarterly, beginning July first, nineteen hun-
5 dred twenty-seven, and continuing during the pleasure of
6 the legislature until otherwise ordered.
