STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Augusta M.
Dolloff of Mount Vernon.

Resolved: That a pension of twenty-five dollars per month
2 be and hereby is granted to Augusta M. Dolloff, of Mount
3 Vernon, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for
4 soldiers and their dependents. Said pension shall begin
5 July first, nineteen hundred twenty-seven, and continue until
6 her government pension shall be increased.
