STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Arthur H. Murch of Paris.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be, 2 and hereby is, granted to Arthur H. Murch, of Paris, to be 3 paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and 4 sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 5 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue until 6 otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu 7 of the state pension which he is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Arthur H. Murch is the son of John M. Murch, who served in Company D, Unattached Infantry, State of Maine, during the Civil War, and who died February 20, 1926. Said Arthur H. Murch is 32 years old and is feeble-minded.
