STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Esther C. Jones,
of Manchester.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month be,
2 and hereby is, granted to Esther C. Jones, of Manchester,
3 to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers
4 and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first,
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue until other-
6 wise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Esther C. Jones is the widow of Thomas C. Jones, who served in Company A, 11th Maine Infantry, during the Civil War. She is 78 years old. She is needy and in very poor health.
