STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Oscar H. Moor
of Portland.

Resolved: That a pension of twelve dollars per month
2 be, and hereby is, granted to Oscar H. Moor, of Portland,
3 to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers
4 and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July first,
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, and continue until
6 otherwise provided by the legislature.
