IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Medway, for Reimbursement of Amount Expended for the Care and Maintenance of Martin Reardon, a Pauper.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to the town of Medway, to reimburse it for the 3 amount expended for the care and maintenance of Martin 4 Reardon, a pauper, the sum of six hundred twenty-four dol-5 lars and fifty cents.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This pauper was boarded in and by the town of Medway for a year and a half. Then there was a law suit regarding his proper residence and he was afterwards taken off the town of Lincoln where the state supported him, and taken to Canada in July, nineteen hundred twenty-five, by immigration officers.
