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AN ACT Relating to Robert W. Traip Academy.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The trustees under the will of Robert W. Traip, late of Kittery, and their successors in trust, for the benefit of Robert W. Traip Academy, are authorized to receive gifts, bequests and devises of real or personal property to be administered according to the terms of the said will and of the instrument creating the gift, devise or bequest and if such instrument contain no specific terms, then for the general purpose of the trust as set forth in said will of Robert W. Traip.

Sect. 2. The acceptance of any gift, devise or bequest by said trustees, and all gifts, bequests and devises made to said trustees are hereby ratified, confirmed and made valid.
