STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN**

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Seventy-five of the Revised
Statutes of Maine Entitled "The Insolvent Law."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter seventy-five of the revised statutes of Maine for
2 the year nineteen hundred sixteen is hereby amended by
3 adding thereto section seventy-two which shall read as
4 follows:

'Sect. 72. Whenever the register of probate in any county
2 shall have in his hands funds arising from any insolvent
3 estate under this chapter and remaining unclaimed for a
4 period of at least twenty years, the judge of probate for
5 said county on petition of said register of probate may, after
6 such notice as said judge of probate deems proper, order

7 such unclaimed funds to be paid over to the treasurer of
8 such county who shall give a receipt therefor specifying
9 the amount thereof and the name and number of the estate
10 from which the said funds arise, which said receipt shall
11 be filed in the probate court for said county as sufficient
12 voucher therefor. No action shall be commenced to recover
13 said funds or any portion thereof after the expiration of
14 six years from the date when said funds are paid over to
15 said county treasurer.'
