### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Cherryfield, in the County of Washington, for Reimbursement for Moneys Expended in Defense of Three Actions at Law Brought Against It.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid the town of Cherryfield, in the county of Washing-3 ton, for reimbursement for moneys expended in defense of 4 three actions at law brought against it, for injuries alleged 5 to have been sustained upon the state highway by reason 6 of alleged defects thereon, the sum of one thousand and 7 thirty-three dollars and fifty-nine cents.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Three actions against this town were brought by three persons who sustained injuries upon the state highway. This matter was taken up with the attorney general's office before and after suits were brought. The cases were successfully defended and this claim is for reimbursement of moneys paid out and to be paid out in connection with these cases; had the plaintiffs obtained judgment, the state would have been liable under section twenty-nine of chapter twenty-five of the revised statutes.
