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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

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RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Smyrna for Support  
of a State Pauper.

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*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to  
2 be paid to the town of Smyrna, the sum of two hundred and  
3 thirty dollars and sixty-four cents, for support of Thomas  
4 W. Pluard, a state pauper, in the year nineteen hundred  
5 and twenty-five.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Thomas W. Pluard had help for himself and children for the reason that he had no way of earning money for support of the family. His wife had deserted and it was necessary for him to be at home to take care of the children. The expense did not continue as a pauper expense beyond April, 1925. The children were taken in charge by the State Board of Children's Guardians. Mr. Pluard's wife was divorced from him and married again and she has since died.
