STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Prentiss for Poultry Killed by Dogs and Wild Animals in the Years Nineteen Hundred and Seventeen and Nineteen Hundred and Eighteen.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Prentiss, the sum of ten hundred and 3 sixteen dollars and fifteen cents, to reimburse said town for 4 money paid for poultry killed by dogs and wild animals in 5 the years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen 6 hundred and eighteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the years 1917 and 1918 the Municipal Officers of the Town of Prentiss paid out over eighteen hundred dollars for domestic animals and poultry killed during those years in said town by dogs and wild animals. The claim was presented to the proper State Department in due season and payment refused. It was presented to the Legislature of 1921, and that portion which was for loss of domestic animals, amounting to \$790.50, was allowed. The entire amount called for by this Resolve is for loss of poultry; none of which has been allowed.
