RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Whitefield, for Reimbursement for Sheep Killed by Dogs.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to 2 be paid to the town of Whitefield, for reimbursement for 3 sheep killed by dogs, the sum of eighty-seven dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The sheep were killed by dogs in nineteen hundred twenty-four and twenty-five. The selectmen made return to the state auditor too late for allowance.
