STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Lee for Support of Oliver T. Lyons, a State Pauper.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to the town of Lee, the sum of seventy-eight dollars 3 and sixty cents, to reimburse said town for money expended 4 for support of Oliver T. Lyons, a state pauper.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This resolve is to cover assistance necessarily furnished Oliver T. Lyons by the town of Lee. The Selectmen of the town of Lee have made every possible effort to find out if this pauper has a settlement, but are unable to fix the liability. He does not belong in the town of Lee. As the town cannot make definite proof that he has no settlement, it cannot collect from the State in the usual manner, and, therefore, asks for reimbursement by action of the Legislature.
