IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians for
the General Care, Maintenance, and Education Thereof.

Penobscot Tribe of Indians, Care and Maintenance.
2 *Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from
3 the state treasury to be expended, under the direction of
4 the governor and council, by the agent of the Penobscot
5 Tribe of Indians, for the benefit of said Tribe, for the year
6 from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to June
7 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, and for the
8 year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, to
9 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine, as follows:

Amounting to twenty-seven thousand, thirty-five dollars and fifty-five cents, for the year from July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight; and twenty-seven thousand, thirty-five dollars and fifty-five cents for the year from the first of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-eight to June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.

And be it further resolved, that any balance of any of the subdivisions above named and not required for the purpose,

3 may, upon recommendation of the state auditor, be trans-
4 ferred by the governor and council to pay bills against any
5 of the above subdivisions, where bills may have been con-
6 tracted in excess of the amount above set forth.
