## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Fees of Sheriffs and Their Deputies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section five of chapter one hundred and eighteen relating
2 to fees of Sheriffs and their deputies as amended by chapter
3 eighty-five of public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty4 five, is hereby amended by adding to said chapter eighty5 five, another section:

'Sect. 2. For serving bills in equity or the subpoena issued 2 thereon, divorce libels, notices of foreclosure of mortgages 3 of real estate, subpoena and application for debtor to disclose 4 before a commissioner, or copies of writs of entry served 5 upon tenants in possession of demanded premises when de-6 fendant is not in possession, the sheriff or his deputy shall

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7 receive the sum of one dollar and twenty-five cents when 8 such service is made in hand, and seventy-five cents when 9 service is made by leaving copy of such of the above as are 10 not required by law to be served in hand at the last and 11 usual place of abode, in addition to his travel, and for the 12 copy, when required to be attested by him, at rate provided 13 in section one, and in all cases, the officer making service 14 shall make a return of his service on the bill or subpoena, 15 libel, notice of foreclosure, citation or other precept, without 16 charge or fee for so doing.

For any of the above enumerated services which a con-2 stable may legally perform, he shall receive the same fee as 3 is provided for deputy sheriff.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby 2 repealed.
