RESOLVE, to Compensate Mary A. Stevens, for Personal Injuries Due to Defect in a Building of the Property of the State of Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of one thousand dollars be, and

2 hereby is, appropriated to compensate Mary A. Stevens, of 3 New Gloucester, in the county of Cumberland, for her per-4 sonal injuries, suffering and damages, suffered by her at 5 Pownal, in said county, on the twenty-sixth day of Septem-6 ber, A. D. 1924, while she, the said Mary A. Stevens was

7 an employee of the state of Maine, in the Maine School for

8 Feeble Minded at said Pownal; said injury and damage being

9 caused by a defect in the asbestos ceiling of the kitchen of

10 said school, which permitted said ceiling to suddenly fall on

11 said Stevens, severely and permanently injuring her, so that
12 she, the said Stevens, because of the same, is now, and in the
13 future will be, unable to work and labor.

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
